The Elland Academy incorporates an exciting 10 place provision that supports students across Key Stage 2.

The Elland Primary Provision is based at The Elland Academy in Leeds, and caters for pupils with social, emotional and mental health needs who, because of the risk of exclusion or other reasons are at risk of disengaging from mainstream education.

Our objective is to ensure the continued education of the children and young people in KS2 in a supportive and nurturing education environment.

ASSESSMENT

Baseline and on-going assessments include behaviour risk assessment, academic baselines and holistic assessments to identify barriers to learning.

Including Thrive and Art based therapies, ELSA Emotional Literacy support and Animal Assisted Therapy.

Admissions & Referrals

We welcome referrals from individual academies, schools and commissions from local authorities. Referrals are accepted for individual places, which we term 'in-reach' provision, in addition to individual or group support for out-reach into an academy or school.

At KS2 we provide 6 weekly assessment places, where we carry out a holistic assessment of individual needs, prior to transitioning a student back into their substantive mainstream place or identified specialist provision.
